At the ITF 42nd Congress in Mexico City (August 3-12, 2010) the delegates overwhelmingly decided to amend the ITF Constitution to establish a Young Transport Workers Committee. Following the passing of the motion, many Affiliates committed themselves to continue their support of the ITF work in the area of young workers.

The ITF Young Transport Workers Committee is comprised of young transport workers under the age of 35 from all regions and sectors of the ITF. The newly established Committee met for the first time November 2-4, 2010, to began working on its Work Programme.

A major portion of this work includes the further development of a communications structure and ITF young workers' network, as a means to ensure that the campaigns and initiatives of the ITF and its affiliates are known to the young workers of the ITF, to allow them to be engaged in the work of the ITF.

As a member of the Committee, I represent North America and am requesting your help. Could you please provide the name and contact information for someone within your union – preferably under the age of 35 – that is willing to receive information from the Committee and distribute it to the young transport workers of your union.
