

# Elect Morteza Maleki for Local 114 Guide



Morteza Maleki is an Iranian activist who immigrated to Canada in the early 80's. He has been working for First Transit since 2004.

In 2006, he helped to organize his fellow workers at First Transit into the CAW, which brought the bus drivers of New Westminster, Tsawwassen and Langley

under CAW (Unifor) union leadership.

Morteza is the Chairperson of our Locals Aboriginal & Racialized Workers Committee (Elected by Acclamation again in 2019).

He is Vice Chair of UNIFOR Vancouver Area Aboriginal & Worker of Colour Committee.

Morteza was a delegate at the UNIFOR Funding Convention in Toronto in 2013 and has attended many BC Federation and BC Regional Council's Conventions since 2011. He participated in various campaigns organized by the Labour movement including the Winnipeg Unifor Convention in 2018.

Morteza is active in Federal and Provincial elections in British Columbia. He has also participated in the Unifor Lobby Work at the Legislature for the Provincial Government in Victoria B.C. Morteza has just received training from Unifor and will be actively participating in the Federal election coming up later this year.



Morteza is active with all the Unifor Functions including Women's Day and other ethnic and community events throughout the year.

He is a member of Iranian Workers Committee in exile and has been active within the International Labour movement to support the Workers' right and struggles in Iran.

Morteza believes by unity we can work towards making this union stronger, more prosperous, and much more successful than before.
